BEACHCOMBER HOLIDAY PARK

INFORMATION + RULES



- › **Check out time is 10am for sites and cabins. Late check outs are subject to availability and charges apply**
- › **Quiet time between 10pm and 7am**, please respect other campers
- › In the interest of safety, the speed limit throughout Beachcomber Holiday Park is 5km/h
- › **Please do not approach or feed the wildlife**, they can be dangerous, be sure to pack away food and rubbish.
- › As you are in a National Park, **no domestic animals** of any kind are allowed
- › We are an Off-grid Eco-park using solar energy for power, harvesting our own water and managing our own waste. We need your help keeping our Eco-park ecological and environmentally friendly! To assist us with this please:
 - › Carry and use a torch after dark. Torches can also be purchased in Office
 - › Keep to designated road ways and refrain from cutting through any sites while walking through the park
 - › Minimise water use, keep showers to under 5 mins, use minimal toilet paper and use the sanitary bins provided as required
 - › Please only **drink water from rainwater taps marked drinking water**. Quality of water from all other taps may not meet health guidelines
 - › Please refrain from putting sanitary products, condoms or wet wipes into the toilet as it will clog up our septic system
 - › Parents please ensure you accompany your children when they are using the amenities block and make sure they are aware of the need to minimize water use and only use small amounts of toilet paper
 - › **No toilet cassettes to be emptied in the Amenities**
- › The Office sells basic convenience items such as milk, ice, bait, ice creams, drinks, etc.

- › Please bring your gas bottle to the Office for refills before 4pm
- › **Mobile phones** and other devices can be charged at Office for a gold coin charity donation
- › Please keep your **cabin or site clean and tidy** and use the facilities provided for drying clothes and rubbish disposal
- › **Under no circumstances can you dig holes or trenches in the Park grounds**
- › **All day visitors, relatives or contractors are to report to Office and sign in before driving through the park**
- › **Children** must be accompanied and supervised by an adult when using the playground and beach, please note that our beach is not patrolled
- › **Vehicles** must be parked on your own site, next to your cabin or in the car park at the entrance of the Park or near Amenities
- › **No smoking is permitted** inside holiday park buildings, cabins or enclosed public areas. Please dispose of cigarette butts appropriately
- › **No wetsuits to be worn in shower block**. Please use beach showers in the huts near the playground
- › **Fish Cleaning** – All fish to be cleaned on the rocks, and remains thrown back into the sea, not in on-site bins
- › **Bicycles, scooters and skateboards** are permitted except where sign posted otherwise. It is essential that safety equipment is worn at all times. No unregistered trail, quad or mini bikes are permitted within the Park
- › Any person who has **damaged park property or that of other guests** will be evicted and held responsible for repair costs. Additional cleaning costs will be charged if cabins or sites are not left in a clean and tidy state
- › Prices, rules and policies are subject to change without notice. Park Management reserves the right to evict any person who fails to obey the park rules. Eviction from the park will result in forfeiture of all monies paid

Rubbish and Recycling

- › General waste bins are situated around the holiday park
- › Glass, aluminum cans and plastic bottles to be placed in recycling bins
- › Do not leave rubbish on the ground where the wildlife can find it
- › Food scraps (excluding onions, citrus fruit, garlic, meat and bread) can be given to our Worm Farm to process this waste. Please speak to staff in Office for more information

Ticks

- › The local wildlife carry ticks on their fur. Should you locate a tick on yourself or children, follow recommended First Aid

Camp Fires

- › All campfires **MUST** be in one of the fire pits provided. No campfires are permitted on the beach. Fines apply to anyone who lights a fire outside the provided fire pits
- › Fire bans must be strictly observed – see fire sign in front of the Office
- › No firewood to be removed from surrounding National Park
- › Firewood is available for purchase at the Office
- › Strictly no beach fires. Fines will apply!

Pizza Oven and BBQs

- › Please book at Office if you would like to use the pizza oven. At least 6 hours' notice is required
- › Pizza bases are available at Office. Please place your order by lunchtime of the day you want the pizza
- › Please clean the pizza oven and BBQs after use
